Whereas, the Little Compton Town Council and Little Compton Planning Board have held joint meetings to conduct a five-year review of the town's Comprehensive Plan, and

Whereas, Chapter 45-22.2 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, a/k/a the Rhode Island Comprehensive Planning and Land Use Act governs the procedures required for the amendment and adoption of Comprehensive Community Plans, which calls for the adoption and/or amendments to be conducted in the same manner provided for the adoption of ordinances in the manner provided for in the home rule charter of the municipality, and

Whereas, the Little Compton Town Council has followed the same procedures for amending the Town's Comprehensive Plan as is required when adopting or amending an ordinance in the Town of Little Compton, and

Whereas, the Little Compton Planning Board upon conclusion of a Public Hearing has recommended to the Town Council that Chapter 6 and Chapter 9 of the Comprehensive Plan be amended,

Now therefore, the Town Council of the Town of Little Compton does hereby accept the recommendation of the Town Planning Board to amend the Comprehensive Plan, adopt said amendments and hereby votes to refer said revised plan to the Director of Administration, Statewide Planning for final approval.

Be It Further Resolved that, upon a satisfactory approval from the Rhode Island Director of Administration Chapter 1, Section 1.6 shall be amended to include the most recent date of amendment as May 7, 2009.
